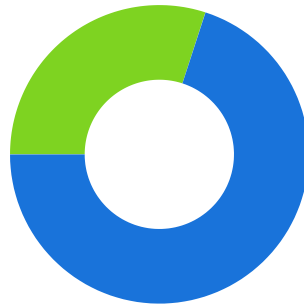

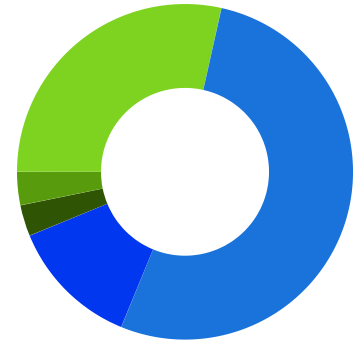

Residency



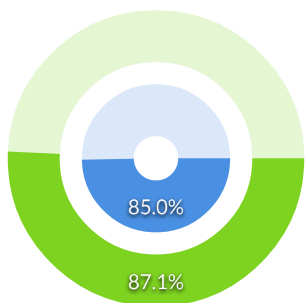
